He was the founding conductor of the Baltimore Symphony Orchestra in 1916, and taught at the Peabody Conservatory. He wrote two operas, Ramona, which premiered in 1916, and The Captive, which premiered at the Lyric Theatre in Baltimore in February 1938.

After a few seasons of performances in the 1890s, the Baltimore Symphony Orchestra officially commenced in 1916, becoming the first municipal symphony orchestra in the country when the Baltimore City Council appropriated \$6,000 for six concerts held at the Lyric Theatre. The 53 member orchestra was first managed by city-appointed Frederick Huber, and conducted by Gustav Strube, head of the Department of Harmony and Composition at Peabody Institute.
